LECTURER in COMMUNITY STUDIES

The successful candidate will teach one second-year, six-credit course (*COMS 2100 Applied Research*) over the Winter semester; evidence of teaching excellence is critical. Candidates should have a Master's degree in a related discipline.

Course Description: COMS-2100 is a core course within the BACS program at Cape Breton University.

Students engage in group projects which apply the problem-solving skills of COMS 1100 and develop additional abilities and techniques of primary research, analysis, and evaluation.

This course is provided as part of the Beinn Mhàbu Year 2 Program in collaboration with Cape Breton University. It is delivered onsite, at the Beinn Mhàbu campus in Mabou, Nova Scotia.

Applicants are expected to demonstrate potential and commitment with regard to teaching, and service to Colaisde na Gàidhlig, community, and profession.
