



## **EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY**

### **LECTURER in HISTORY**

Beinn Mhàbu, a campus of Colaisde na Gàidhlig | The Gaelic College invites applications for a full-time, limited term Lecturer position in History. This position will commence August 30, 2023 and end October 24, 2023, with the possibility of renewal.

Beinn Mhàbu delivers a unique, culturally focused, and community-based educational experience to all who become part of its community.

The successful candidate will teach one first-year, six-credit History course (History of the Gael) over six weeks in the Fall semester; evidence of teaching excellence is critical. Candidates should have a Master's of History or in a related discipline.

*Course Description: This course brings students on a journey through time, from the Celtic tribes of Central Europe before Roman conquest through to present day in Nova Scotia. The course is divided into three sections with the first focusing on early Celtic history through to Somerled and the establishment of the Lordship of the Isles. The second section will delve into a "Gaelic golden age" until the Battle of Culloden (1746). The final section considers the Highland Clearances, the establishment of new Gaidhealtachdan (Gaelic speaking areas) in North America and elsewhere, and the ensuing decline and more recent revitalization of Gaelic, with a focus on Nova Scotia.*

This course is provided as part of the Beinn Mhàbu Foundation Year Program (*Gaelic Foundations: Living Cultures*), in collaboration with Cape Breton University. Students will be able to continue in CBU's BA or BACS program. It is delivered onsite at the Beinn Mhàbu campus in Mabou, Nova Scotia.

Applicants are expected to demonstrate potential and commitment with regard to teaching and service to Colaisde na Gàidhlig, community and profession.
